Student Korea Trip Preparation

Students should consider the following when planning their trip to Korea:

1. We recommend limiting your baggage to one large suitcase and one carry-on piece; also you should pack an empty bag to bring back your souvenirs and shopping items.
2. Obtain a passport or update your current passport.
3. Bring an international travel adapter for electrical appliances, such as hair dryers, shavers and curling irons.
4. Pack several t-shirts, workout sweats, etc. and a pair of athletic shoes.
5. You should also bring a couple of your own uniforms if you will participate in TKD championship or training.
6. Bring along a swimsuit and/or comfortable shorts, casual clothing for heat and rain, as well as clothing for cooler weather. (Day time average temperature is 85 F, while night time temperature is cooler and there is about 15 % humidity.) Don't forget sun screen, sunglasses and/or a hat for sunny days.
7. Include at least one Business Attire for Special Occasions and/or Opening and Closing ceremonies.
8. Provide your own personal toiletries, such as toothbrush, toothpaste, shaving cream, razor, shampoo, etc.
9. Don't forget your camera, memory cards, film and replacement batteries (or battery recharger) for lots of photos.
10. Binoculars may be enjoyable on sightseeing tours in scenic areas.
11. Cash or traveler's checks are recommended for convenience in exchanging US for Korean currency (traveler's checks may only be exchanged at banks and at the Airport. The current rate of the 1 US Dollar is 1000-1,200 Korean Won this may change Day by Day). About \$500 per person is recommended – this is just spending money. There are some additional fees during the trip, small tips for drivers and tour guides and Gift of appreciations
12. Bring an international calling card to phone home during your visit (you may be able to buy Calling Cards in Korea).
13. All students (or parent/guardian if under 18) will be required to sign a Consent and Release form before the Korea Trip to participate in the scheduled Championship, training and Culture expo events.
14. On the exciting days you spend in Seoul for shopping, sightseeing, and free time, you will be responsible for your own ground transportation, food, and personal expenses – except for scheduled group events.
15. Because you will be making friends from Korea and other visiting countries, it may be a good idea to bring small gifts from the USA to share with your new friends, tour guides, etc.
